

TANZANIA CRICKET ASSOCIATION DEVELOPMENT REPORT APRIL 2012 TO JUNE 2012

DOMESTIC LEAGUE:

Six teams participated in the DRCC T20 T1 league played from 14-01-2012 to 20-05- 2012. The finals were played by Academy Boys v/s AKSC. Academy Boys won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 104 all out in the 20 allotted over's. In reply AKSC scored 105/4 in 18 over's to win the finals by 6wks.

The final of the DRCC T20 T2 with eight teams participating was played by Veecom V/S Dar gymkhana. Veecom won the toss and elected to bat scoring 44 all out in 14 over's and in reply Dar Gymkhana scored 45/1 runs in 8.5over and clinch the winner's trophy.

The final of the DRCC T20 T3 was played by Veecom Dev v/s TCA U17. Veecom won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 86 runs in the 20 allotted over's. In defending their score, Veecom dismissed TCA U17 to 68 runs all out to win the T3 league.

The T20 Ramadan league shall commence in the month of Ramadan with 7 teams taking part.

REGIONAL TOURNAMENT:

The TCA organized a regional cricket tournament during Easter holidays from 6/4/2012 to 10/4/2012. Four teams from different regions battled

hard in the 50 over's version of the game held in Arusha. All the matches were played at the TGT and new Olyset ground. Four teams namely Dar es Salaam, Morogoro, Mombasa and host Arusha participated in the event. Most of the games were won by a very narrow margin. Dar es Salaam and Morogoro qualified for the finals of event. Morogoro won the toss and elected to bat and were restricted to 145 all out in 43 by DSM's superb bowling attack. In chasing the low scoring DSM lost their 8 wks to win the 2012 regional event.



DRCC WOMEN'S 40 OVER'S LEAGUE:

Six senior women's teams participate in the 40 over DRCC Women's league. Dsm Academy girls and Ulugulu qualified for the final. Academy girls won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 143 runs all out in their 40 allotted over's. In defending their score with fierce bowling from Hawa Salum dismissing the whole batting line up of Uluruguru Girls for just 23 runs



EDUCATION COURSE:

Level 1 refresher Umpiring Seminar:

Taking the advantage of the regional tournament and to cut down the budget costs a two day refresher Level 1 Umpire's seminar was held at the Monjes Hotel on the 7th & 8th April 2012 to 20 candidates. The objective of the seminar was to update all the candidates on the latest playing conditions and the new laws of the game. The seminar was conducted by Kazim Nasser.



UMPIRES BEGINNERS COURSE:

A two day umpiring course was held at the muhimbili cricket academy on the 14/06/2012 to 15/06/2012. A batch of 23 junior umpires who have been officiating in the school leagues and other junior leagues participated in this course.



BEGINNERS COURSE MWANZA

The Association has targeted Butimba Teachers College to conduct most of its educational programs in future. The Butimba College is the hub of sports teacher.

The college produces hundreds of sports teachers every year who are then allocated by the Ministry to various municipal schools in Tanzania. The first successful three day introductory beginner's cricket coaching course was conducted by Zully Rehemtulla and assisted by Hamisi Abdullah from 18th to 20th April 2012. A total of 23 sports teachers from the college participated in this three day coaching course that covered all the basic aspects of the game including the basic laws of the modified game for juniors



JUNIOR INVOLVEMENT:

The TCA development committee organized a one day "chanzo" cricket tournament for beginners in DSM region on the 28 & 29/04/2012 for both gender at the UDSM ground. A total of 40 primary school teams i.e. 20 Boy's teams and 20 girl's team participated in this tournament. Transport-shirts, Lunch, water and soft drinks were provided by the association to all the participants.





Junior Leagues:

T20 Primary school leagues for both genders are near to completion in all the three regions. In DSM a total of 20 boys and 16 girls teams are competing with other 20 boys team and 14 girls team in Morogoro, and 14 boys team and 12 girls in Arusha.

Facilities:

The Association has constructed a full size ground at the Butimba Teachers College in Mwanza shall be ready by end of July. On completion the new ground will serve the ongoing development program in Mwanza and also be utilized by local clubs for the domestic leagues in Mwanza.
