## DEVELOPMENT REPORT MAY 2010

### DOMESTIC LEAGUE DSM:

The finals of DRCC T20 league 2010 were played on the 16<sup>th</sup> May at the Anadil Burhani ground to conclude the prolonged event due to the heavy rains. In Div 'A' Anadil Burhani played Aga Khan Club. Burhani won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 126 /8 in the allotted 20 overs'. In return Anadil's Spinner Aziz Paliwala and Imran Essajee bowled well to defend their team's score by restricting Aga Khan Club to 86 all out in 18 over's to become the champions of T20 2010.



The finals of 'B' Div were played between Upanga Club and B. United. Upanga won the toss and decided to field first and restricting B.Uinted to 61 runs in 19over's with all their wickets out. In chasing the score Upanga's opening batsman Adil Kassam scored a comfortable 50 runs taking his team to a easy victory in the 'B' Div leagueof the T20 2010.

Upanga being the winner's of 'B' Div played a play off v/s Morogoro Stars the last team on the table in the 'A' div and won the game by 2 runs to be promoted in 'A' Div for next DRCC 50 over league.
