JAN TO APRIL 2011

DOMESTIC LEAGUES:

DRCC LEAGUE:

The DRCC 50 over league finals in A Div were played by Academy Boys vs Upanga at UDSM ground on 6/2/2011. Academy boys won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 259 for nine wickets in their allotted 50 over's. In defending the score the



Academy Boys restricted Upanga Club by dismissing their whole batting line up in 40 Overs for just 148 runs on the score board.

Similarly the final of the B Div between Academy Dev B and veecom was played at the Annadil Burhani ground on the 15 Jan 2011. Academy Dev won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 154 runs for ten wickets in 28.4 over's in their 30 allotted over's'. In chasing the score Veecom managed to score 54 runs for ten wickets in 19.3 over's allowing the Academy Dev side to emerge the champions.

The C Div finals were played by Union Youths v/s Union green on the 22nd Jan 2011. Union youth Won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 121. In return Union green chased the score comfortably scoring 123 runs for 3 wickets to emerge the champions.

The final of the D Div on the 22nd Jan 2011 was played between kigogo stars and schools combine side. Kigogo won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 130 for

4 wickets. School combine managed to score 25 runs for all out and hence kigogo emerged the champions.

APL T20 2010:

The annually played advanced Players league (APL) was held in Dar es Salaam for third consecutive year from 11th to 16 February was a great successful with four teams competing in the event. The event was partly sponsored by “TIGO” a mobile communication company in Tanzania. The four competing teams namely Simba hunters, Uluguru stars, Dar devils and the Twiga’s warriors comprising of the national team players. In order to make this event competitive TCA invited



nine other player foreign players to join the event. Simba Hunters fielded three players from S.Africa, while Uluguru stars fielded three players from India and Dar Devils fielded three players from Kenya with rest of the local players selected from the domestic leagues. The main objective of this event was that our local players to learn gain experience by playing with these international players. All the games were very exciting that saw the teams winning with a very narrow margin. This year TCA kept Tshs One Million price money for the winning team.

The Finals were played between Twiga warriors and Dar Devil.



Twiga warriors won the toss and elected to bat first scoring 128 in the allotted 20 over's. In defending the score Twiga Warrior restricted Dar Devils by dismissing all their batters for 97 runs to emerge the winners of the event.

Regional U17 Event:

The regional U17 event was played at the SUA ground in Morogoro during the Easter Holidays. One team from Arusha and two teams each from DSM and Morogoro participated in four day competition. The final were played between Uluguru stars and Dar eleven. Uluguru won the toss and elected to bat first scouring 75 for 9 wickets in 20 over's. In reply Dar eleven scored 76 for 5 wickets in 18.5 over's to emerge the winners of the tournament.



JUNIOR LEAGUE:

More junior teams have enrolled to participate in the junior league in all the regions compare to the year 2009 and 2010. It is indeed a testimony towards the growth of the game at junior level which will eventually move towards the senior level in the near future.

Dar es Salaam:

The annually played T20 primary school league for both genders took off on the 26th of March 2011 in Dar es Salaam. A total of 20 boy's teams have participated divided into four groups of five teams each playing a round robin with top team in each group qualifying for semi finals and the final. While in the girls' category a total of 14 teams have participated divided into two groups playing a round robin with two top teams qualifying for semi finals and the final.

Morogoro:

A similar primary school league in Morogoro took off on the 02nd March to see 16 boy's team and 14 girls team participating. The 16 boys' team is divided into four groups of four teams all groups playing the round robin format with the top in each group qualifying for the semi finals and finals. While 14 girls team were divided into two groups playing the round robin with two top team from each group qualifying for the semi finals and final.

Arusha:

In Arusha the primary school league started early with 10 boys team and 8 girls team divided into two groups in each category playing the round robin with top two in each group qualifying for semi finals and final.
